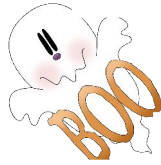

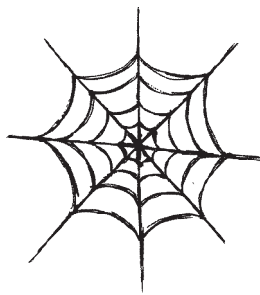

Principal's Letter



Dear Saint James School Families,

Happy Halloween! Today we celebrate all hallows eve which reminds us that tomorrow is the feast of All Saints. Tonight many of our students will dress in their favorite costume and trick or treat in their neighborhoods. The candy or treats they receive will be around for a while, but the stories of the saints remain with us for our lifetimes. As I mentioned in a previous RAM review, the accreditation goal, which our school is working toward this school year, is the use of data to guide instruction of all students so that they reach their academic potential. This data is not only collected from the STAR Renaissance standardized tests that students complete several times during the school year, but also through teacher created tests and activities, book assignments, observation, and projects. By reviewing where a student is currently performing and looking ahead to where they should be, teachers adjust their instruction to provide specific learning activities to bridge the gap. Teachers will be conferencing with parents in late November about student academic performance based on these assessments. I want to encourage parents to use the feedback to provide any needed support at home. Our mission states that we work together in partnership with parents to provide a Christ-centered, safe, and creative environment for learning. Students have the best opportunities for success when this partnership is in place.

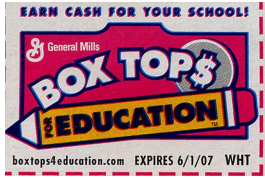
