Through these events, schools focus on the value Catholic education provides to young people and its contributions to our church, our communities and our nation.

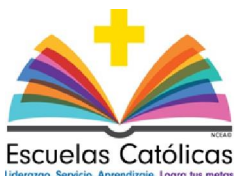

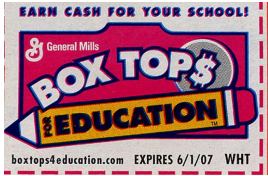
