There will be no Extended Care available for the last day of school on June 14th. Dismissal is at 11:30AM and **ALL** children must be picked up at this time.

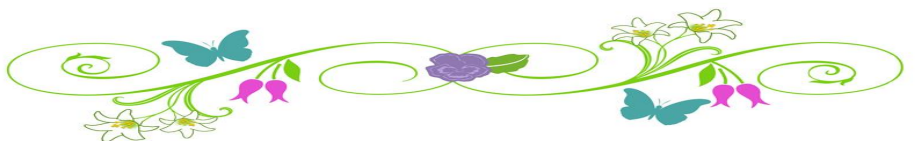

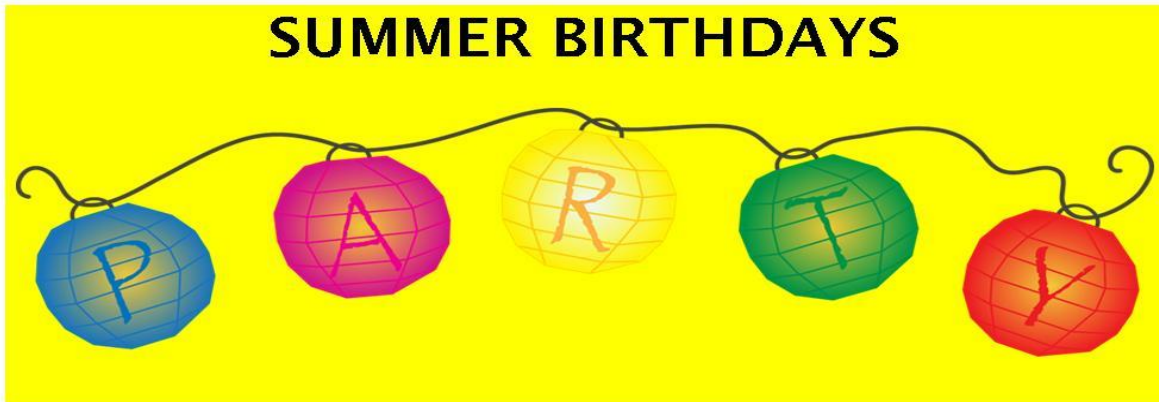

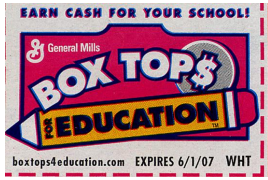
